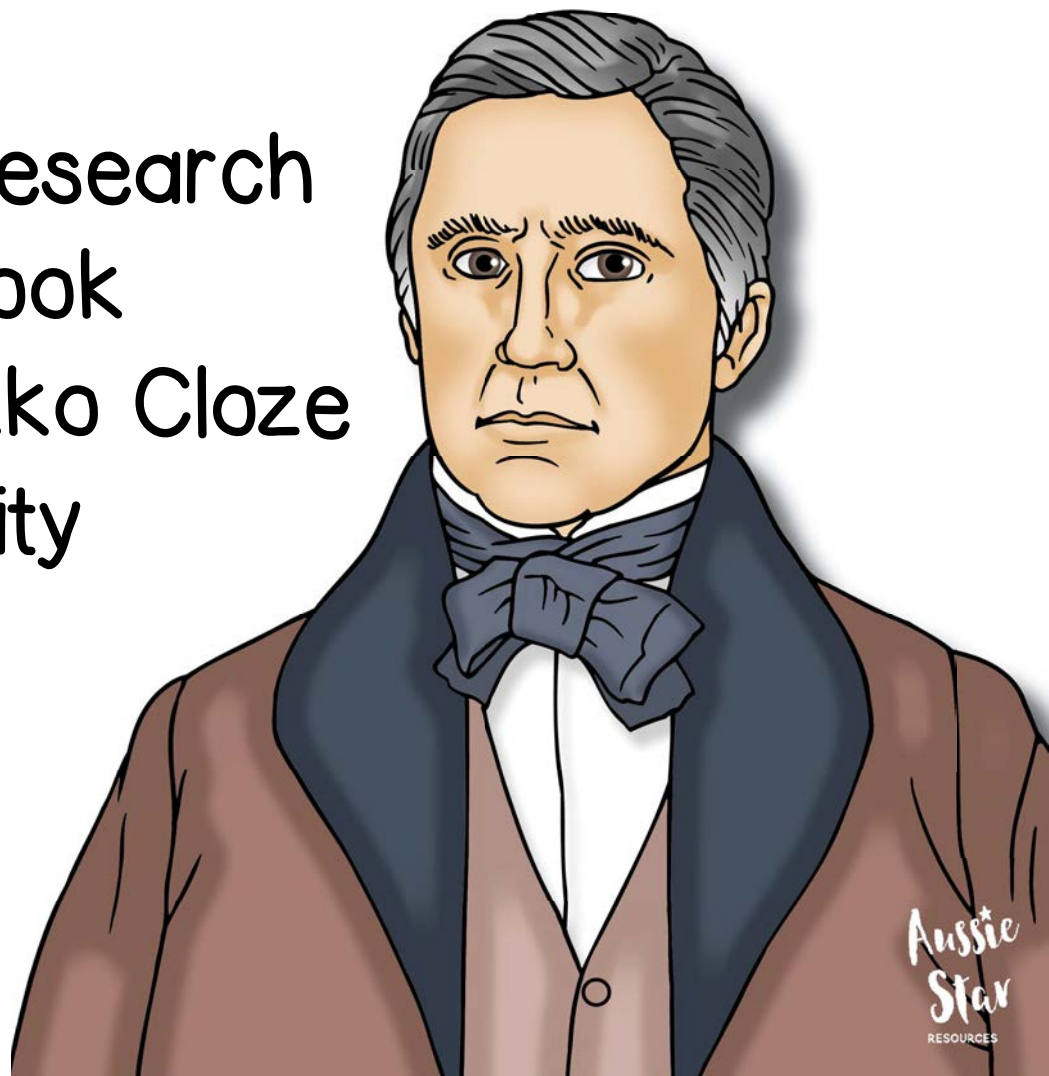

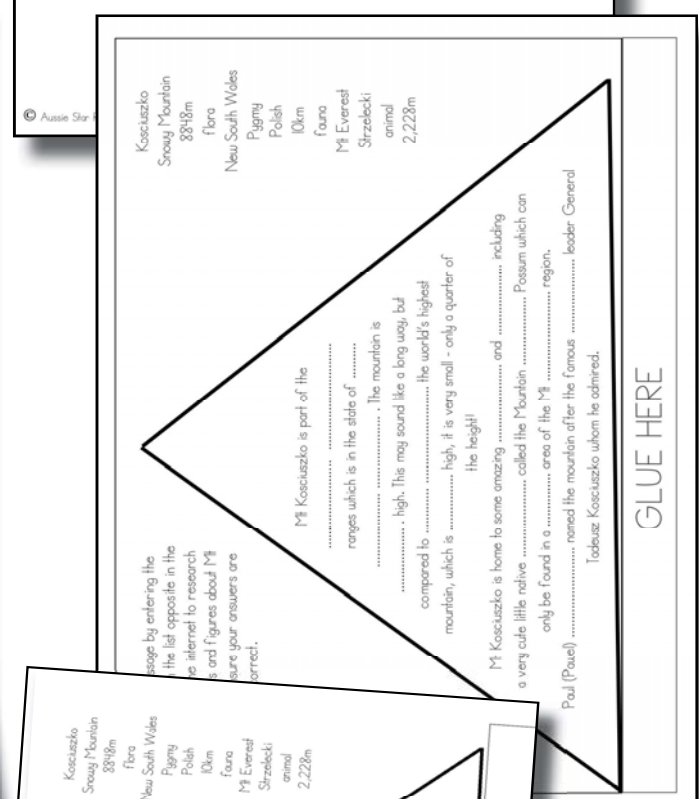
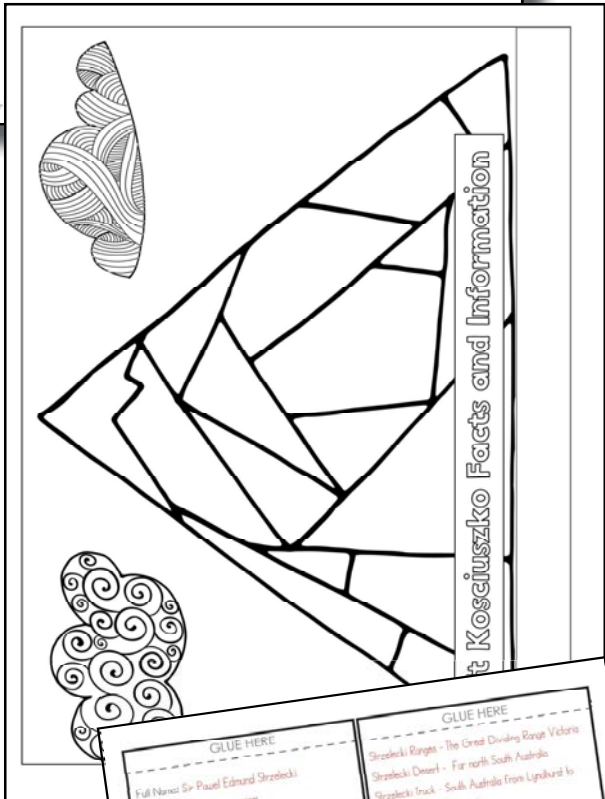

Mā Kosciuszko is part of the **SNOWY MOUNTAIN** ranges which is in the state of **NEW SOUTH WALES**. The mountain is **2,228m** high. It is very small - only a quarter of the height of **Mt Everest**. Kosciuszko is home to some amazing **FLORA** and **FAUNA** including a very cute little native **ANIMAL** called the Mountain **PYGMAY**. Possum which can only be found in a **1000m** area of the **Mā Kosciuszko** region.

Paul (Pawel) **STRZELECKI** named the mountain after the famous **POLISH** leader General **Tadeusz Kosciuszko** whom he admired.
