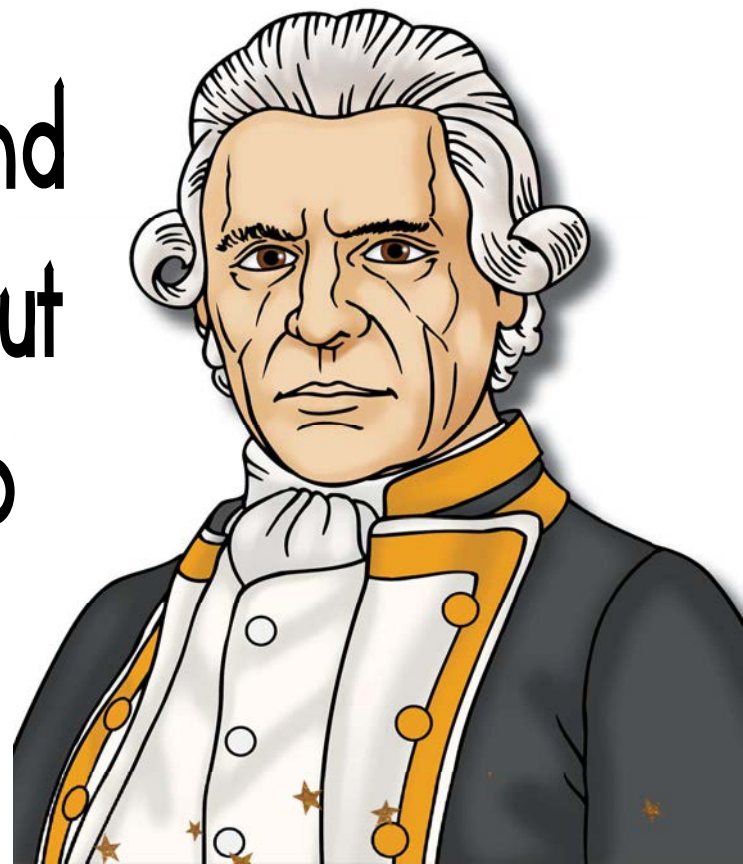

The Three Voyages of Captain Cook

Five Fast Facts

- The HMB Endeavour was Captain Cook's first ship for his three voyages.
- The Endeavour could accommodate up to 100 crewmen.
- The crew had different roles, there was a sail maker, a carpenter, servants and a botanist named Sir Joseph Banks who documented and recorded the animal and plant life they discovered on their journey.
- When Cook and his crew arrived in Tahiti it was so lovely, and the people were so friendly that some of Cook's men wanted to stay there!
- In 1770 The Endeavour hit coral on the Great Barrier Reef and the expedition had to stop while the ship was repaired. Many of Cook's men caught malaria during this time and 30 of them died.
